Weaver Middle School 2020 - 2021 Dress Code Policy

At Weaver Middle School, each student will demonstrate strength of character and dress for success in preparation for college or career opportunities

Appropriate Attire	Attire Not Permitted
<p>Students may wear the following:</p> <p><u>PANTS OR SKIRTS (Must have Belt loops):</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain khaki or black pants or plain khaki or black skirts. • However, jeans are only permitted on days designated by the Principal • Shorts may be worn during the spring and summer months – must be dress code • Pants must be of appropriate size, not flare legged, worn as designed and of ankle length. Pants designed to be worn below the top of the hip bone are not allowed. • Pants MUST have belt loops and MUST be worn with a belt. • Pants MUST NOT be tucked into shoes or socks. • Skirts must be no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee. (Fall Below all the Students fingers) • BELTS MUST BE WORN DAILY (ONLY BLACK OR BROWN BELTS) – No Sagging Pants 	<p>Students may NOT wear the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cargo pants are NOT allowed. • Tight fitted clothes are NOT allowed. • Skirts cannot have any slits or openings. • Jeans are permitted special days and will be announced. Jeans may not have any holes, frays, or tears. • Absolutely No Sagging of Pants <p>Jewelry</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dog tags are not allowed • Pendants and earrings larger than a quarter and multiple bracelets are not allowed • Face Piercings are not allowed <p>Hair</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dyed hair that is not a natural color or shade is not allowed with the exception of scheduled spirit day activities by the school • Un-natural hair color includes, but not limited to, hair that is dyed pink, purple, bright red, yellow, blue or green (Not allowed) <p>* Hoodies <i>MAY NOT BE WORN in the building</i></p> <p>****Only Clear or Mesh Bookbags Allowed****</p>
<p><u>SHIRTS/TOPS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain white, maroon/burgundy, yellow/gold, pink, gray, or black polo shirts ONLY • Polo shirts must have a collar, long or short sleeved • Sweatshirts or sweaters (no hoodies), or plain white, maroon, yellow, pink, or black color shirts, sweatshirts and sweaters • All shirts must be of appropriate size and must be tucked • Plain white undershirts or turtlenecks underneath polo shirts, school t-shirts, sweatshirts and sweaters. 	
<p><u>JACKETS/COATS:</u></p> <p>*Coats must be placed in lockers upon arrival to school</p> <p>*Lightweight jackets with no hoods can be worn in the classroom. School Colors/Jean Jackets ONLY</p>	
<p><u>SHOES/SOCKS:</u></p> <p>ONLY SCHOOL COLOR TENNIS SHOES CAN BE WORN; SHOE LACES THAT ARE THE APPROPRIATE SIZE FOR THE SHOE ONLY. All shoes must have closed toes and heels WHITE OR BLACK soft soled shoes (no heels allowed). Plain white socks are to be worn with the tennis shoes.</p>	
<p><u>Bookbags – Clear or Mesh Only</u></p>	

Any item prohibited in the Bibb County Board of Education Guidelines for Success or Dress Code is NOT allowed. All items, which in the judgement of the Principal (or designee), disrupts or distracts from the teaching and learning process will not be allowed.
